- Sahana Open Source Disaster Management Platform
- Helps organizations and communities prepare for and respond to disasters
- Started in Sri Lanka after the Indian Ocean Tsunami
- Deployed in over 25 countries
- Used by many different organizations including national and local governments, Red Cross and the UN.

Directory of organizations, offices and people to support communication and coordination



Incident management sharing real-time information




Who's Doing What Where (3W) information to identify where there are gaps and overlaps



Records what **resources** are available and where to support disaster





Brings all information together in a single platform to provide situational awareness.



Sahana's Features

- Mapping: All geographic data can be displayed on a map
- Authorization: All data is controlled by configurable permissions which allow for granular access by user, organization or office.
- Reporting: All data can be filtered and represented on matrix reports, pivot tables and charts
- Data Integration: Web Services via RESTful API.
 Data import/export to CSV, XLS, XML or JSON.

- You are encouraged to engage with the community and share your contributions




