- Increased motivation for regional cooperation and connectivity



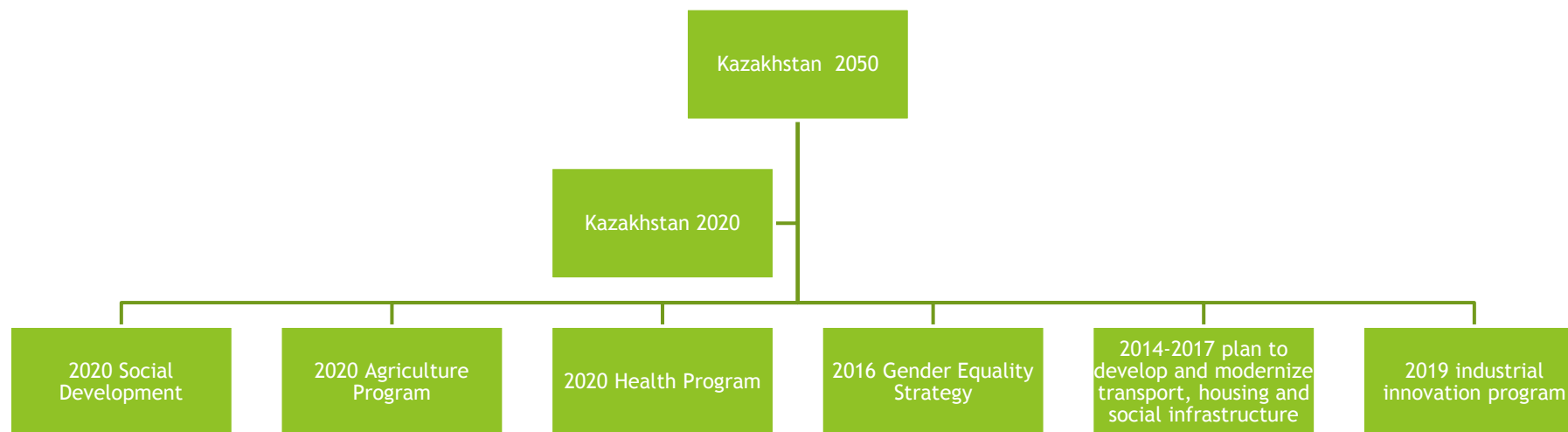
# 2012: adoption of Kazakhstan 2050 Strategy
